SECTION A - SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION

The purpose of this modification is to incorporate a revised Purchase Description (dated 25 March 2003) into the contract. These changes are a result of numerous discussions over the last few years, some relating to testing, and some not related to testing. These changes are summarized as follows:

1. Paragraph 3.5: Part of this paragraph was revised to read: WARNING, EAR PROTECTION REQUIRED WHEN OPERATING THIS VEHICLE OR WITHIN 23 FEET OF THIS VEHICLE WHEN OPERATING.
2. Paragraph 3.9.1 Part of the paragraph was changed to read as follows: Components and accessories removed for sectionalization shall be stored in the helicopter slingable container. All tools required for re-assembly shall be stored on the vehicle.
3. Paragraph 3.10.2: The commercial 613C II accomplishes emergency/backup braking in a manner different from that described in ISO 3450. The 613C II braking system uses spring applied, air released brakes which assures that anytime there is a power failure or emergency shutdown, the brakes automatically apply as the air pressure that holds them in a disengaged mode reduces to no pressure. ISO 3450 was deleted.
4. Paragraph 3.15.8.4: During operation, the ASWDS shall be capable of recycling power after exposure to the high altitude electromagnetic environment with component replacement, within 12 hours.
5. Paragraph 3.18.4: There is some disassembly and assembly needed to reduce machine height for GIC transport. The PD was changed to allow removal of ROPS/FOPS and lowering of elevator, etc. for rail transport.
6. Paragraph. 3.21: Development of the instruction plates will not be completed until after the machines have completed all phases of contractor and government testing. Table I of the PD has been changed to remove inspection of the instruction plates for the FAT vehicles. Also, the last two sentences are deleted because they relate to data requirements.
7. Paragraph. 3.24: PD changed to require silicone brake fluid. (Cost impact previously negotiated and incorporated.)
8. Paragraph 3.29: Caterpillar is supplying the appropriate commercial alternatives to the NSN's listed, so "or its commercial equivalent" has been added.
9. Paragraph 4.5.2.9: The reference to paragraph 3.11.2 has been corrected to 3.10.2.
10. Paragraph 3.31: Added SAE J185.

The new PD ATPD-2310 will replace the current PD as exhibit L.

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
