OMNIBUS III-BACKGROUND

- OMNIBUS III was awarded in December 2007 and included 8 prime contractors; 5 large and 3 small businesses
- 5 year BPAs issued against GSA Multiple Award Schedules (MAS) with Federal Supply Schedule (FSS) contractors. OMNIBUS III is currently in year 3.
- During open season in December 2008, 4 new Small Business Primes were added which totaled 12** Companies/BPAs; 5 large and 7 small businesses
- Open Season is held once each year to allow Prime contractors to rearrange their team members and subcontractors and/or add or delete contractors
- Customers include PEO for Combat Services & Combat Service Systems (PEO CS&CSS); PEO Ground Combat Systems (PEO GCS); PM for Systems Integration; US Army Research, Development and Engineering Center (TARDEC); TACOM LCMC Depots and Arsenals; PM Light Armored Vehicles (LAV)*; Foreign Military Sales (FMS)* and ILSC*.

*will be added during Open Season this year

**One small business BPA was terminated at the end of 2009 so currently there are 5 large and 6 small businesses under OMNIBUS III.

OVERVIEW

- ⦿ White-Collar, Competitive, Commercial Services
- ⦿ A GSA Multiple Award Schedule (MAS) Blanket Purchase Agreements –FAR 8.405
- ⦿ These BPAs/task orders provide a means to strategically consider the most effective method of satisfying recurring service requirements
- ⦿ Requirements of FAR 6 (competition requirements) and 15.3 (source selection) do NOT apply. FAR 8.4 applies.
- ⦿ FFP, FFP with EPA, FFP LOE and T&M type task orders
- ⦿ 1 base year, 2 option years available.
- ⦿ SCA Department of Labor (DOL) Wage Determinations not required
- ⦿ Average award time is 60-90 days once requirements package is *complete and accurate*

OVERVIEW CONTINUED

- No synopsis required
- No competitive range determinations
- No Source Selection Plans required
- Streamlined evaluation procedures
- Fair Opportunity given to all 11 contractors -5 large & 6 small
- Best-value trade-off procedures using technical adjectival ratings
- Past Performance need not be evaluated-AFARS 5116-50590(d)
- No discussions or proposal revisions; may get minor clarifications
- No 51% rule
- Teams consist of Primes/leads, teammates and subcontractors

GSA SCHEDULES COVERED BY OMNIBUS III BPA HOLDERS:

- ◎ **GSA Schedule 871 - Professional Engineering Services (PES)**
- ◎ **GSA Schedule 874 - Management, Organizational, and Business Improvement Services (MOBIS)**
- ◎ **GSA Schedule 874V - Logistics Worldwide (LOGWORLD)**

Flexible Pricing Arrangements; pre-established rates off these GSA Federal Supply Schedules and discounts

NOTE: On the TOR, a determination must be made where the preponderance of work falls under which schedule. Contractors are allowed to propose using a different GSA schedule they may have if the same labor categories are included to perform the work.

FAIR OPPORTUNITY – ORDERING PROCEDURES

- ◎ All task orders are split into two Domains, whether PES, Logworld or MOBIS:
 - Domain 1: Task Orders estimated to be less than or equal to \$600K /year
 - Domain 2: Task Orders estimated to be greater than \$600K/year
- ◎ If estimated to be less than or equal to \$600K/year, a large business can propose but must offer up a small business teammate as a Direct Award. The Direct Awardee must perform at least 35% of the work per year, as measured in dollars.
- ◎ Small Business BPA holders can propose in either Domain.

FAIR OPPORTUNITY – ORDERING PROCEDURES

CONTINUED

- Direct Awards to Small Businesses: This process occurs when a large business wants to participate in Domain 1.
- The Direct Awardee must perform at least 35% of the work per year, as measured in dollars.
- Domain 1 was created to increase small business participation. The large business teammate of the award recipient will receive credit for the direct award against the 15% small business participation goal for this yearly period of performance per BPA Provision (9) REQUIREMENT FOR SUBCONTRACTING WITH SMALL BUSINESSES.
- If a Prime large business proposes one of their small business Teammates for a Direct Award, the Services Contracting Team will be responsible for creating a separate administrative BPA to this small business with the same clauses and provisions, by reference, as the Prime's terms & conditions.
- If a requirement is solicited as > \$600K (Domain 2), but offers come in under <\$600K, the requirement will be re-solicited in Domain 1.

OPEN SEASON OCTOBER 2010

- ⦿ We will add and delete contractors to the BPAs this Open Season.
- ⦿ The Award Term criterion remains the same but will be closely monitored this year and in year 2 (2009) to evaluate and choose BPA holders in 2011 (see next slide).
- ⦿ Open Season will occur approximately 15 Oct 2010.
- ⦿ Exhibit D, CDRL A001 entitled, Performance Review Report –your self assessment for your firm will be due in October for 2010 performance.
- ⦿ New Offices that will be added this year: Integrated Logistics Support Center (ILSC); Foreign Military Sales (FMS); and PM Light Armored Vehicles (LAV).

OPEN SEASON - BPA AWARD TERM CRITERIA

Additional one (1) year BPA performance periods may be awarded during each year based on how the contractor has performed against the following criteria:

- ◎ (1) Task Order Performance;
- ◎ (2) Actual performance versus proposed goals for:
 - (i) Direct awards to small business team members; and,
 - (ii) Small business subcontracting;
- ◎ (3) Responsiveness;
- ◎ (4) Competitiveness.
