H.1.2.6 The Contractor is authorized to use without charge, on a rent-free non-interference basis, the Government furnished property listed on H.1.2.1 through H.1.2.3.1

H.1.2.7 The Government shall furnish such other items of Government-owned property as the COTR or Contracting Officer deems necessary to assist the Contractor to expedite performance of this contract. This includes: hardware, supplies, support parts, and technical documentation required to support power pack level Engineering testing.

H.2 SELECTION OF COMPONENTS

H.2.1 General. The Contractor shall not knowingly perform work called for by this contract in such a manner as to produce end results that are not susceptible of reproduction by or for the Government using equipment and components which are readily available through

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Government or commercial channels and by standard or proven production techniques, methods, and processes, provided such is practicable from the standpoint of performance, cost and other such considerations. Accordingly, unless approved by this contract, (i) produce an end result requiring the Government to pay patent royalties, technical assistance fees, or other such costs for using equipment, production techniques, methods, or processes, or an end item having incorporated into it any part, component, subassembly, or combination thereof covered by a patent which is not competitively obtainable by the Government from two or more sources.

In the development of items for the Government, the provisions of this subparagraph do not require the Contractor to make any special investigations to determine the existence or non-existence of patents and do not apply to standard military components.

**H.2.2 Use of Standard Military Components:** In the performance of the Contractor is required to make maximum use of the TACOM Military Standard Component Directory. The Contractor is allowed maximum design freedom in the selection of components of commercial origin or in the design of new components specifically for the end item provided such selection of design is consistent with requirements to make maximum use of standard military components. The recommendation by the Contractor for the introduction into the contract item of a component is not a standard military component, but which offers only marginal improvement over a standard military component, is to be avoided. Any item known to the Contractor to be in the Army Supply System which may not have been formally designated as a standard item is to be used in the preference to the creation of a new part subject to Government approval.

**H.2.3 Use of Privately Developed Components:** When the Contractor is convinced that the design of the contract item would be jeopardized by failure to incorporate a certain privately developed component, the Contractor, prior to incorporation of such components into the design of the end item, must submit in writing the following:

**H.2.3.1** A complete description of the component and reproducible prints of drawings and specifications of the component to enable evaluation thereof which may be marked with the restrictive legend found in the DFARS 252.227.7013 Rights in Technical Data Noncommercial Items. Such complete description and such reproducible print so submitted and so marked with such legend shall not come within the scope of data specified to be furnished or delivered under this contract.

**H.2.3.2** A statement that if the component is approved and introduced into the contract item, the Contractor shall furnish complete assembly and detail drawings sufficient for manufacture of the component by other than the original supplier, or if this is impossible, envelope drawings with data sufficient to satisfy requirements for secondary item procurement and subject to unlimited rights with the exception of proprietary items, accordance with Rights to Technical Data and Computer Software clause of the contract.

**H.2.3.3** A statement that there is, or is not, an existing Standard Military Component that could be used, based on standards, directories, or other data supplied to the contractor by the Government or available to the Contractor.

**H.2.3.4** If the answer to Paragraph H.2.3.3 above is yes, the Contractor shall describe those features of the recommended component which off marked improvements over the existing Standard Military Component and he shall also justify the substitution.

**H.2.3.5** If the answer to Paragraph H.2.3.3 above is no, the Contractor shall submit reason and justification to establish the necessity of the use of the recommended component and provide an estimate of the time and cost to generate, under the contract, an item which would satisfy the design requirements of the contract item.

**H.3 COMPONENTS OF NEW DESIGN WHICH ARE LIKELY TO BECOME REPAIR PARTS:** Regarding those components of new design which are normally utilized or expected to be used in servicing the item, the following procedure must be followed: When the Contractor is convinced that the design of the contract item would be jeopardized by failure to incorporate certain components of new design, which shall offer marked improvements over the standard military components, the Contractor, prior to incorporation of such items into the design of the contract item, shall submit in writing the following:

**H.3.1.1** A complete description and sketch sufficient in detail to enable evaluation of the proposed component; and

**H.3.1.2** A statement that there is, or is not, an existing Standard Military Component that could be used, based on standards, directories, or other data supplied to the contractor by the Government or available to the Contractor.

**H.3.1.3** If the answer to Paragraph H.3.1.2 above is yes, the Contractor shall describe those features of the recommended component which off marked improvements over the existing Standard Military Component and he shall also justify the substitution.

**H.4 SUBMISSION AND EMERGENCY APPROVAL:** The Contractor shall submit information as required by Paragraph H.2.3.3 and H.2.3.4 above in to permit the Government to perform its necessary screening evaluation for approval; however, the Government may authorize expeditious emergency approval. When such approval is granted the written information as prescribed herein shall be furnished for confirmation.

**H.5 DISAPPROVAL:** If the use of a component which has been recommended by the Contractor is disapproved, the Technical Representative may direct the use of such other components which satisfies the design requirements as furnished to the contractor. Any such direction which involves a change in the estimated cost or time for performance of this contract hereof entitled Changes.
