SECTION E - INSPECTION AND ACCEPTANCE
INSPECTION AND ACCEPTANCE

Product Inspection and First Article Test Provisions

E-1 Inspection. All inspections (including tests) and acceptance shall be conducted in accordance with the requirements of the complete technical data package (TDP) 11-1-2060-2 (16 ft.), 11-1-2060-4 (24 ft.), and associated parts lists (PL)), specifications and standards that are specified in the TDP. The contractor shall flow-down all contract and technical data package (TDP) requirements to vendors and suppliers of parts and component items for the coupling assembly airdrop contract. Vendors and suppliers of parts and component items shall provide certifications (i.e., material, process, test, mechanical properties, tensile, hardness, heat treatment, stress relief, et al.) and shall be supported by objective quality evidence of supplied and fabricated items. Vendor and supplier certifications shall first have been accepted by the prime contractor prior to offering the certifications to the Government for acceptance.

E-1.1 Conformance Inspection. The contractor shall conduct conformance inspection in accordance with the requirements of the product drawings, specifications and Quality Assurance Provisions (QAPs), as specified in the TDP.

E-1.2 Welder Qualification. All contractor personnel performing welding and weld inspections shall be certified to the requirements of AWS (American Welding Society) D1.1. All welder certifications shall be current and available for government review at anytime. Accordingly, all weld procedures shall be current and meet the requirements of AWS D1.1.

E-1.3 Nondestructive Testing. Nondestructive testing and inspection, such as magnetic particle inspection and other methods, shall be performed by personnel trained and certified in accordance with NAS 410 (Standard for Qualification and Certification of Nondestructive Testing Personnel).

E-2 First Article Test (FAT). The contractor shall conduct a First Article on the complete coupling assembly, airdrop, 11-1-2060, for 11-1-2060, 16 ft. and 11-1-2060-4, 24 ft., to verify conformance of all technical requirements that are specified in the technical data package (TDP) and 11-1-4220, 11-1-4221 and 11-1-4222.

E-2.1 Prior to conduct of the FAT, the contractor shall completely conduct 100 percent inspection and test of all component items that comprise the coupling assembly airdrop, prior to assembly, as specified in the TDP.

E-2.2 All inspections and test results shall be documented and provided in the First Article Test Report, to include, dimensions, finish, functional tests, surface finish, certifications (materials, tests, hardness, mechanical properties, tensile, process, heat treatment, stress relief, Nondestructive inspection (magnetic particle), welder, chemical analysis/chemical composition, and markings)).

E-3 Failure of First Article Test (FAT). Failure of the FAT, as a result of defects associated with the TDP, shall be cause for rejection of the FAT unit, until objective evidence has been provided by the contractor that root cause failure analysis and root cause corrective actions have been taken to eliminate the defect. Any defect found during FAT shall be evidence that all coupling assemblies and/or coupling components (and manufacturing processes) are similarly deficient, unless the contractor produces objective evidence that proves to the contrary that all characteristic items conform to the TDP requirements and were not impacted by defects found during the FAT. Accordingly, correction of any and all defects shall be at no increase in the contract price.

E-4 First Article Retest. In the event of failure of the FAT, the Government reserves the right to retest the same or another coupling assembly airdrop upon correction of the defect(s) by the contractor to the complete extent and duration, as specified in the contract, to the satisfaction of the Procuring Contracting Officer (PCO). If another coupling assembly airdrop is selected, the contractor shall be responsible for all deficiencies detected, regardless of the relationship to the original test failure and shall comply with the provision of E-3, at no additional cost to the Government.

E-5 First Article Test Plan (FATP). The contractor shall prepare a First Article Test Plan that describes in detail all inspection, test, and TDP requirements for conduct of the FAT (CDRL A002).

E-6 First Article Test Report (FATR). The contractor shall prepare a detailed First Article Test Report of all inspections and test results that emanated from the FAT, as required by E-2, to include all certifications, as specified. The FAT Report, including all characteristic items, certifications and processes, shall first have been accepted by the contractor prior to submittal of the FAT Report to the Government. (CDRL A002)
