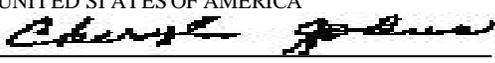

The following have been added by full text:

MOD P00002

1. The purpose of this contract modification P00002 is to modify TACOM clause 52.242-4022, "Delivery Schedule (Sep 2008)" in Section F of the contract as provided below to (i) provide for the initial delivery of ordered Vibratory Plate Compactors as described in CLIN 0002 within a stated number of days after contractor's receipt of notice from the Government of the Contracting Officer's approval or conditional approval of the First Articles submitted by the contractor pursuant to FAR 52.209-4, "First Article Approval – Government Testing"; (ii) to provide the contractor with an additional 30 days to make the initial required delivery against an issued delivery order as requested by the contractor; (iii) to identify a range of from 30 to 60 end items that may be included in each sequential delivery provided for in delivery orders issued under the contract; and (iv) to require the Government's prior written approval as a precondition for the contractor's acceleration of deliveries under any delivery order issued under the contract. The Government shall have the right to designate in each issued delivery order the specific quantity of end items to be included in each sequential delivery within the aforesaid 30 to 60 quantity range.
2. In connection with this contract modification P00002, the contractor acknowledges and agrees that (i) the Government shall use its best efforts to provide for the notification of first article test (FAT) approval, conditional approval or disapproval by the Contracting Officer within the 150 calendar day period identified in paragraph (b) of FAR 52.209-4 as included in Section I of the contract and that (ii) the Contractor waives and holds the Government harmless from any liability whatsoever for claims arising from or related to the Government's inability to provide for the notice of FAT approval, conditional approval or disapproval within the aforesaid 150 calendar day period.
3. The contractor and the Government acknowledge and agree that the waiver of liability on the part of the contractor as set forth in paragraph 2 above and the flexibility provided to the Government by the modifications to the "Delivery Schedule" clause (TACOM clause 52,242-4022) described at phrases (iii) and (iv) in paragraph 1 above constitute adequate and valid consideration for the 30 day extension of the time for initial deliveries granted to the contractor as described in phrase (ii) of paragraph 1 above.
4. Except as modified by this modification P00002 and the prior modification P00001, the terms and conditions of the contract as awarded remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

## SECTION F - DELIVERIES OR PERFORMANCE

The following have been modified:

## 52.242-4022 (TACOM) DELIVERY SCHEDULE (SEP 2008)

(a) Delivery under this delivery order contract must conform to the required schedule specified below, unless acceleration is acceptable.

(b) Definitions:

(1) DAYS means the number of days after the contractor's receipt of a delivery order or if First Article Test (FAT) is required, contractor's receipt of notice of FAT approval or conditional FAT approval, when the contractor must deliver the stated (QTY) of supplies.

(2) DELIVERY is defined as follows:

FOB Origin - Contractor is required to deliver its shipment as provided in FAR 52.247-29(a)(1)-(4) by the time specified in the individual contract; or

FOB Destination - Contractor is required to deliver its shipment as provided in FAR 52.247-34(a)(1)-(2) by the time specified in the individual contract. The contractor must take into consideration the length of time necessary to deliver its shipment to the destination designated in the contract, to ensure that the item reaches its destination by the time reflected in the contract.

(c) The Government requires delivery to be made according to the following schedule:
