

**Notice and Acknowledgement Regarding Controlled Unclassified Information (CUI)
to be Distributed for the EMD Phase of the Ground Combat Vehicle (GCV) Program**

The recipients of the technical data to be distributed hereunder are informed that: a) the data are associated with the GCV FBO Special Notice titled W56HZV-13-GCV-SPEC_CDD; and b) the documents are to be used only for the purpose of preparing a proposal for the GCV program and/or gaining knowledge to work as a contractor or subcontractor for the GCV program. Interested parties are also given notice of the treatment they are required to give these CUI technical data documents, and are asked to acknowledge their compliance with these stated handling expectations of Program Manager GCV.

Identification of Relevant CUI:

These technical data include the Draft CDD (Capabilities Development Document), the Draft GCV IFV EMD Performance Specification, the GCV Security Classification Guide with associated DD254 Classification Specification and CUI Handling Instructions.

Recipient Identification:

As an initial matter, the recipients are required to provide the following information before they will be given the technical data:

1. Company name, and CAGE code,
2. Name, title and contact information for an authorized representative of your company
3. Name and contact information for your company's Facility Security Officer (FSO).
4. Name and contact information for your company's Defense Security Service (DSS) Representative.

Distribution Statements:

The recipients are asked to note that all of the CUI technical data are marked with Distribution Statements and that these Distribution Statements vary from document to document. The first sentence of the Distribution Statements describes the distribution allowed for that technical data, but please note that there likely are also other conditions, described in the CUI Handling Instructions that are also applicable.

Protection of Collateral Classified and Unclassified Information:

Collateral classified information generated in support of the associating PM GCV FBO Special Notice shall be classified in accordance with the source material used or the Security Classification Guide (SCG) for PM GCV, dated 24 Jan 2012, and protected in accordance with the National Industrial Security Program Operating Manual (NISPOM) DoD 5220.22-M, DoD and DA Directives, Manuals, and Regulations.

Unclassified information shall be protected IAW the Security Classification Guide (SCG) for PM GCV, dated 24 Jan 2012, and protected in accordance with the National Industrial Security Program Operating Manual (NISPOM) DoD 5220.22-M, DoD and DA Directives, Manuals, and Regulations.

Destruction Requirements:

The Recipient acknowledges its obligation to destroy these Data, and all copies of the Data in its possession, no later than 30 days after: i) the award of the initial GCV procurement contract; or ii) following such a request from the government. In either case, the Recipient shall provide written confirmation to the GCV PCO that it has completed such destruction.
