Government response to ProcNet questions:

1. Question: Could you advise the definition or specify what is considered "technical information" and considered export controlled?

Answer: "Technical information" in regards to what is posted in this context is the ARL document defining the armor package. This ARL document is also export controlled.

2. In addition document DoDD 5230 25 Notice to Accompany Export-Controlled, also posted to the site references "Technical Data".

Question: Is "Technical Data" referenced on DoDD 5230 25, the same as "technical information" referenced in above paragraph?

Answer: "Technical Data" referenced on DoDD 5230 25 is any technical information as it relates to the entire Heavy Crane system. "Technical information" as it relates to this posting is the ARL document defining the armor package. Also ITAR and export controlled.

PEO CS&CSS cannot give guidance to contractors as they are responsible for interpreting the law and abiding by it. ITAR is managed by the State Department and must be interpreted and followed for the duration of this contract.

3. Question: Is "Technical Data" referenced on DoDD 5230 25 considered "Technical Data" per definition of ITAR 120.11? If so, is the crane blueprints, drawings, photographs and plans also considered export controlled or only the armor portion?

Answer: PEO CS&CSS cannot give guidance to contractors as they are responsible for interpreting the law and abiding by it. ITAR is managed by the State Department and must be interpreted and followed for the duration of this contract.
