

1. Question received:

The Request for Information (RFI) posted on 8 November 2013, in support of TACOM Strategic Service Solutions (TS3), requires the respondent to "provide a list of labor categories that your company envisions as potentially necessary to complete the work described for each general area: (1) Knowledge Based Services; (2) Facility and Equipment Related Services; and (3) Research and Development Services."

The RFI goes on to state the "Performance Work Statements for each of the three areas can be found at the official TS3 website: <https://contracting.tacom.army.mil/services/TS3/TS3-RFPwebpage.htm>."

I have scoured the referenced website and am only able to locate the attached Statement of Work, which does not delineate scope within each general area. Did the government intend to refer potential respondents to the Performance Work Statements for each Representative Task Order?
