

**SOURCES SOUGHT MARKET SURVEY**  
**Systems Technical Support (STS) for Family of Heavy Tactical Vehicles (FHTV)**

- 1. Market Survey Request.** This is a SOURCES SOUGHT MARKET SURVEY (hereafter referred to as market survey) to request information for Government planning purposes only. Responses will assist the United States Government (USG) in planning its acquisition strategy for a potential future acquisition. The USG is not committed to issue a solicitation or award a contract as a result of this announcement. Since this is a market survey and not a solicitation for receipt of proposals or quotations, the USG does not encourage questions concerning this market research.
- 2. Clarification of this Action.** This request is an inquiry intended to measure the level of industry interest in competing for a potential USG contract. Responses to this survey may affirm the USG's decision to issue the subject contract for full and open competition. This is not a pre-solicitation notice or a Request for Proposal (RFP). A contract will not be awarded from this announcement. Information provided regarding the potential contract as presented in this market survey is subject to change. Additionally, as a market survey, this inquiry does not bind the USG to solicit for or award a competitive contract. Participation in the market survey is wholly voluntary on the part of the contractor as no reimbursements will be made to any contractor for costs associated with its participation in this market survey. Data submitted to the USG will not be returned, but will remain archived as part of the market survey's historic records. Lastly, participation in this market survey, while important to Army acquisition planners, is neither mandatory nor is it requisite to future participation by the contractor in this or a similar contract RFP.

3. Technical: PdM HTV is planning on contracting for system support services related to PdM HTV's portfolio of heavy tactical vehicles. These services will include engineering design and integration, obsolescence management, technical manual updates, spare parts provisioning, packaging development, and related efforts. This notice seeks to identify firms staffed and capable of executing support efforts described above for currently fielded heavy tactical vehicle platforms. Describe your firm's experience and corporate knowledge in the development and integration of heavy tactical vehicles that are expected to achieve highly challenging interoperability, vehicle and crew survivability, mobility, supportability, availability, affordability and transportability objectives. In addition, describe your firm's ability to develop and integrate: reliable replacement systems and sub-systems; analyze failed systems and parts and provide solutions or substitutes; improved capabilities or new technologies for heavy tactical vehicles. What products/services does your company primarily offer?
4. Facilities: This notice seeks to identify firms that have or can develop and obtain the expertise, capacity, facilities, and qualifications for potentially managing, designing, and developing solutions for fielded heavy tactical vehicles. Describe your firm's facilities, analysis tools, and vehicle or component prototyping capabilities which would be used to execute assigned support efforts.
5. Management: Describe, with references to past experience (contract number, supervising agencies and other applicable documentation/details), your firm's capabilities in terms of expertise, corporate knowledge, processes and environments necessary to manage complex technology developments and integration of these developments into existing vehicle platforms. Describe your firm's ability and experience in handling classified aspects of a program.
6. Experience: Describe your firm's capabilities and experience in developing and producing engineering and logistics solutions for vehicles and systems. Describe your firm's existing efforts that are potentially comparable and applicable to this effort. The Government does not own the Technical Data Packages (TDP) for the heavy tactical vehicle platforms needing system support. Describe your firm's experience with reverse engineering whole vehicle platforms, vehicle systems, or sub-systems. If your firm has done reverse engineering in the past, provide the time needed to reverse engineer and complete the project. Include any past contracts with the Government where reverse engineering was part of the contract deliverable or required to meet the contract deliverable. The approximate number of vehicle platforms which may need support is 28. Describe your firm's capability to stand up a team equipped with well-established processes for product development and integration. Describe your firm's systems engineering expertise, processes, and environments that a complex development effort will require and the integration of these activities/products to achieve the established system-level objectives. Describe your firm's experience or expertise supporting the Army's technical manuals, spare parts support, and required data submissions to support fielded vehicles and spare parts procurements. Identify if your firm utilizes an established quality control system.
